Re: COVID-19 and Governor Holcomb's Stay-At-Home Order

Yesterday, Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb issued Executive Order 20-08. It directs Hoosiers to stay at home to help stop the spread of the novel coronavirus, or COVID-19. The order is effective at 11:59pm on March 24, 2020 through 11:59pm on April 6, 2020.

- **Number 14, section t of the order lists real estate services as essential including appraisal and title services.**
- **Number 16, section a of the order allows those providing essential services to travel for work.**
- **Number 16, section a of the order also allows those accessing essential services to travel.**

REALTORS® and their clients may still conduct the activities necessary to buy and sell real estate in Indiana during the time period covered by the order so long as they comply with the social distancing requirements also in the order.
